Announcement for Community Action for Mosquito Control – August 24, 2016

The Asian Tiger Mosquito is present in Phillipsburg and surrounding areas. This mosquito is an aggressive day-time biter that is capable of spreading several mosquito-borne diseases. Asian tiger mosquitoes require small containers of standing water to survive. The easiest way to eliminate these mosquitoes is to get rid of standing water around your home.

Please dump the water from containers, such as buckets, kiddie pools, and plant saucers. Drain standing water from tarps and pool covers. Recycle tires and other containers properly. Bird baths and pet dishes should be scrubbed weekly to eliminate mosquito eggs. Report swimming pools that are not maintained. Defend yourself from mosquito bites by wearing repellents and securing window and door screens.
